Describe in detail your Lodge's community project.

The Elk Hunt for Fitness focuses on family fun, and encourages fitness and bike safety. The event is scheduled for about three hours, Saturday morning, October 13th. It will be two person teams in four divisions: family, female, male & co-ed. After a bicycle safety presentation by an officer from the New Braunfels Police Dept., the event will kick off with a bicycle ride around scenic New Braunfels to hunt for Elk photos we positioned earlier. Bikers will then return to the Lodge for a fun and simple fitness activity, then on their bikes for another Elk hunt. There will be 4 or 5 Elk Hunts depending on the division. The event will be timed to encourage competition. After the bike ride we will serve a lunch of hamburgers and hot dogs, and give away door prizes. How does your Lodge plan to promote the use of this grant in the community?
