

What that means and how to fix it.



This short presentation will cover why your Lodge is out of compliance, how to resolve the problem, and what happens after the issue is resolved.

So you might ask ...



What does being out of grant compliance mean?

This is a term the ENF uses for Lodges that are currently ineligible to apply for grants. This is not a permanent status and is often easily fixed.



Why Your Lodge is Out of Compliance

The most common reason a Lodge is out of compliance is due to a missing or incomplete Final Report Form from prior grant years.



CIP TIP

If you're unsure why your Lodge is out of compliance, contact the CIP. We can quickly look to see what the issue is.

How can my Lodge get back in grant compliance?



Contact the CIP

Our office will let you know what the issue is.



Gather the needed info

Whether the Lodge is missing one Final Report Form or receipts from a past grant.



Send it in

Fill out the necessary forms with signatures or find all missing receipts & then return it to the ENF.



That's it!

Once we receive the necessary documents, we will close out the grant and your Lodge will be back in grant compliance!
