



I can become an Actor, and star in a movie Me as Captain America! That would be groovy!



CHAPTER TWO: EMERGENCY EDUCATIONAL GRANTS



s tragedy befalls the children of deceased or totally disabled Elks, a Fairy Godmother of sorts swoops in to help. No, she doesn't wear a fluffy white dress and sprinkle stardust, but she does make their college dreams come true. Through the

Emergency Educational Grant program, these children receive financial assistance to attend college. Students must demonstrate financial need to qualify for a grant under this program. In addition, the applicant must be unmarried, under the age of 23 at the time of applying, and be attending a U.S. college or university as a full-time undergraduate student.

Grants range up to \$4,000 and are intended for educational assistance only, not to cover the entire cost of a college education. TURNING TRAGEDY INTO TRIUMPH

On a fateful night in 2000, William Chapman II died in a car accident. He left behind a wife, Cathy; a son in college, Brandon; and two daughters in high school, Kaylan and Dana. Dealing with the unimaginable, his family tried to pick up the pieces and find direction at a time when life seemed hopeless.

William's children continued to look to their father for guidance. Remembering his advice, they focused on achieving their educational goals, as he had always urged them.

"My dad believed a good education makes a strong foundation for your life," says Kaylan.

William, an Elk from Elkins, W.V., didn't get to watch his daughter Kaylan graduate from Fairmont State last spring or his son, Brandon, graduate from West Point in 2003. And he won't get to watch his daughter Dana walk across the stage at Fairmont State next summer. Although he's missing his children's graduation ceremonies, he certainly helped them get there.

"My dad always told me and my siblings to find something we truly enjoyed," says Kaylan. "That's what I did."

Inspired by her father's career in engineering, Kaylan majored in Occupational Safety and is pursuing a Master's degree in Safety Management. Next year, Dana also will graduate with a degree in Occupational Safety. She plans to attend graduate school. Brandon is a Captain in the US Army. He's currently serving his third tour of duty in Iraq.

Eight years ago, it was hard for Cathy Chapman to imagine her family moving on. With a child in college, two more on the way, and an elderly father to care for, she knew she couldn't do it on her own. Luckily, William's other family—the Elks—stepped in. Kaylan and Dana applied for and received Emergency Educational Grants to help pay for college.

"The support given by the EEG program has allowed me to do what my father wanted," Dana explains, "get an education in a field where I can make a difference."

William Chapman II loved his family. And he loved the Elks. He shaped the lives of his children by encouraging them to dream big for their futures. Now, the Elks are helping to make those dreams come true.

"I want to make a difference in the world somehow," explains Kaylan. "I want to live up to my family's tradition of being the best—especially my dad's—since my last name is Chapman."

CHAPTER THREE: THE NATIONAL HOOP SHOOT



nce upon a time, on a playground in Oregon, a young boy sat on the sidelines watching the bigger boys play ball. He dreamt of the day when he'd grow big enough and tall enough to join them. It

felt like that day would never come.

Alas, the Elks National Hoop Shoot Free Throw Contest was born. On that day, in 1946, the playing field was leveled. All kids, big and small, short and tall, could play as one at the free-throw line. For it no longer mattered how close you were to the rim. The arc of your shot and the swish of the net revealed the winner. The young boy smiled, and left the sidelines behind.

Since that day, the Hoop Shoot has grown into a national program with more than 3 million participants each year. The contest begins at the local level, with winners advancing through district, state and regional competition to reach the national finals.

Six national champions are crowned in Springfield, Mass., each year—one boy and one girl in each of the three age categories. The top girl and boy shooters, regardless of age-group, are awarded the Getty Powell Award, an honor named after the Hoop Shoot's first National Director, and are invited to attend the Elks National Convention. The 2008 Getty Powell recipients are Jacob Hartle and BriAnna Burbridge.

EYE ON THE BALL

In the town of Frankfort, Ky., 10-year-old BriAnna Burbridge lies in bed thinking about her future. She has a vision. Literally. She dreams of becoming an eye doctor when she grows up.

"I want to make sure that people have the right glasses and that they can see," she explains.

BriAnna knows firsthand the importance of good eyesight. During the 2008 Hoop Shoot National Finals, she shot a perfect 25 out of 25 to claim first-place in the 8- to 9-year-old girls division and the Getty Powell award for best overall female shooter. She kept her cool during a tense situation, never losing sight of the basket and her goal of winning.

"I was so excited when I won that I called everyone I knew," recalls BriAnna.

Like her idol, college sports star Victoria Dunlap, BriAnna plans to wear the University of Kentucky uniform someday. And she's not limiting herself to one sport!

"Victoria Dunlap plays the same position as me, forward, and we also have the same number," she says. "Victoria also runs track like I do, and we both do the long jump. How cool!"

Although BriAnna counts Dunlap as one of her favorite athletes, she

might be surprised to find that she could teach Dunlap something about free-throw shooting. Dunlap finished her freshman season with a freethrow percentage of less than .500!

BriAnna had her first trip to Disneyland this summer when she addressed the Elks during their convention in Anaheim. The experience was so great that she went home and told her friends about it.

"I want to tell my friends how much fun the Hoop Shoot was so that they might sign up for it next year," she says.

Soon to be a sixth-grader, BriAnna loves math and science. Outside of the classroom, she's hard to keep up with! She not only loves basketball, but she also runs cross-country and track! Keeping her eye on the future and her plan to become an eye doctor, Brianna's busy sports schedule helps get her in perfect shape to chase down her dreams.

In the town of Winston-Salem, N.C., 11-year-old Jacob Hartle lies in bed dreaming of his future. He pictures himself on the basketball court, unselfishly leading his teammates to an NCAA victory wearing the North Carolina Tar Heels uniform. In Jacob's mind, his future looks remarkably like Tyler Hansbrough's, his favorite athlete.

"I like Tyler Hansbrough because he is strong," explains Jacob. "And he's a team player."

Judging by his performance during the 2008 Hoop Shoot National Finals, Jacob might soon be giving Hansbrough a run for his money. Shooting a cool 25 out of 25, Jacob clinched first place in the 10- to 11-year-old boys division, and his score proved to be good enough to earn him the title of 2008 Getty Powell winner.

Just like many famous champions before him, he went to Disneyland! Jacob addressed the Elks at their annual convention in Anaheim in July.

"This was my first trip out west," Jacob explains. "I was so excited!"

Entering sixth grade this fall, Jacob has a lot to be excited about. He's a proud member of an AAU basketball team and a USSSA baseball team, but he still finds time to focus on his schoolwork.

"I like recess the most," he says. "Just kidding, I really like math."

When he's not using his math skills to count the number of free throws he's made, Jacob uses them to count his sports trophies and accomplishments. But despite his basketball success, Jacob is keeping his options for the future open. If he doesn't end up in the NBA, becoming the next Dustin Pedroia and playing for the Boston Red Sox sounds good, too.



Like many other high school students whose Elks families have allowed them an elite scholarship opportunity, Erin McCreary has been surrounded by Elks values throughout her life. So when she found out that she won a 2008 Elks Nationa Foundation Legacy Award, Erin was doubly grateful for the impact of the Elks in her life.

"This scholarship is both generous and sentimental, because the Elks have meant so much to my family," she explains.

The Elks are not the only ones who have demonstrated the spirit of generosity. In addition to her studies, Erin participated in many volunteer activities during high school. Most notably, she completed a comprehensive project to earn a Girl Scout Gold Award. She chose to promote internet child safety. During a

These experiences have prepared Erin to greet the next phase of her life, and her father and grandfather have much to be proud of. As she packs for the 15-hour drive to Auburn University this fall, Erin will carry with her the lessons and values she has learned from her family, her service experience, and the Elks.



A Quest for Knowledge

he quest for the title started with many. More than 15,000 entered the ring. But only an elite 500 would walk away with the prize—a four-year Elks National Foundation Most Valuable

Student scholarship. Of this elite group, Megan Spencer of Lodi, Calif. and Donovan Barfield of Vidor, Texas, emerged the fairest of them all to claim first-place honors.

With the introduction of fourth-through seventh-place awards, the Elks National Foundation awarded a total of \$2.296 million in Most Valuable Student awards in 2008. That's an \$80,000 increase over previous years! The scholarships are awarded to students over four years. The two first-place recipients receive a total of \$60,000 each; two second-place recipients, a total of \$40,000 each; two third-place, a total of \$20,000 each; two fourth-place, a total of \$16,000 each; two fifth-place, a total of \$12,000 each; four sixth-place, a total of \$10,000 each; and four seventh-place, a total of \$8,000 each. The 482 runners-up each receive a \$4,000 scholarship.

Applications for the 2009 contest, open to any high school senior who is a U.S. citizen, will be available beginning September 1, 2008 online at *www.elks.org/enf/scholars*, at local Elks Lodges, or by sending a self-addressed, stamped envelope to the Elks National Foundation. 
