DEFENSIVE DRIVING UPDATE FOR THE UNDER 50 CROWD



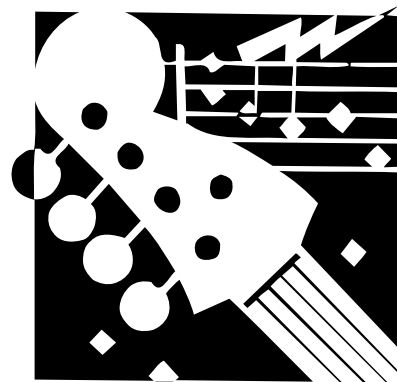

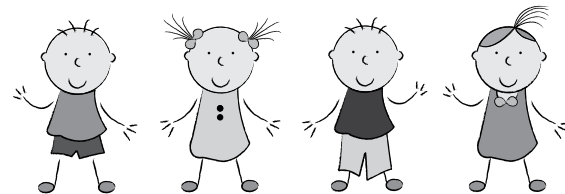
