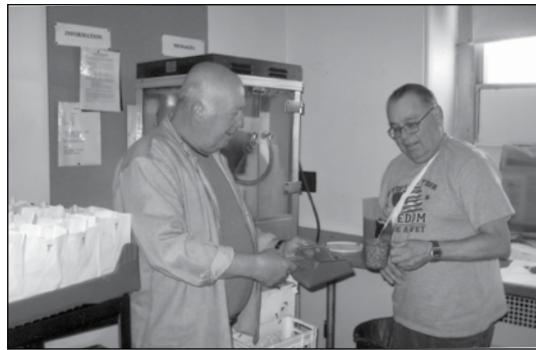
VETERANS CORNER

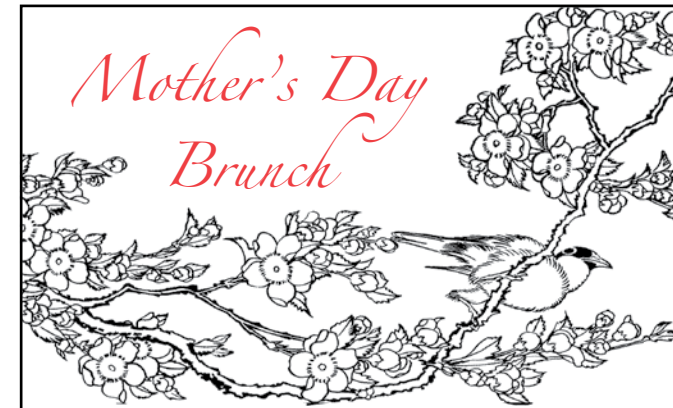
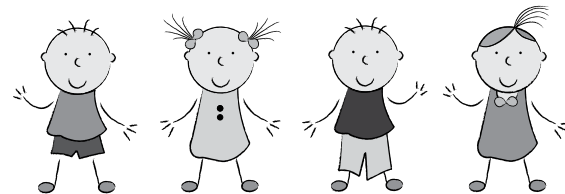
