Who Master Trooper Kyle Was ...

Trooper Kyle P. Barber grew up in Queensbury, NY where he graduated in 1980. He moved to Texas to attend DeVry Institute, met his wife, who was originally from South Glens Falls. They moved back to this area for a year then relocated to North Carolina.

Kyle P. Barber served as a trooper for the North Carolina Highway Patrol, Troop F, District 2 Patrol Office in Wilkesboro North Carolina from January 1985 until his untimely death on May 19, 2009; **24 Years of dedicated service.** He is survived by his wife, three children, his parents, 3 brothers and 2 sisters and their families.

Kyle P. Barber was a member of the Wilkes Telephone Board of Directors, was a member of the Shepherds Crossroads Volunteer Fire Department Board of Directors, and coached girl's soccer at East Wilkes High School;

Kyle P. Barber was a leading citizen, an outstanding law enforcement officer and was always dedicated to the welfare of the citizens of Wilkes County and sincerely committed to the fundamental principles of good government.

As you remember these fallen officers, take comfort in recalling that they dedicated their lives to the same principles of honor, duty and courage that brought you to the badge.
