





Changes are happening!! Currently the Dining Room is being closed for Saturday nights but the food and service is still available through the Club Room. This is due to the lower number of turnouts for Saturday dining and what it takes, we feel, to maintain the dining room and salad bar financially. This will also allow the Dining Room to be available for smaller party bookings that we may otherwise lose due to the size and rental costs of the upstairs Banquet Room.

As of the first of December, the Saturday Morning Breakfasts will be discontinued unless there is a substantial increase of numbers that start coming in. The past few weeks have seen less than 10 members on any given morning.

There are new prices for drinks in November and this will seriously be looked at for continuing months to come. Saturday, Sunday, Monday, and Wednesday drafts are \$1.00, Bottles are \$1.50, and Rails are \$1.75. The pricing on Tuesday's for Members night are sill the same.

Starting in January the price for Tuesday's Member's Night dinner will be \$8.00 for the special and \$10.00 for the alternate steak dinner with Tea or fountain soda included. Carry outs will be the same price but are limited to a small box for the salads. Also being initiated the first of January will be an increase of pricing across the board for all the buffets and lunches. These increases are still being analyzed, and may stay the same but not include your drinks with the meal price.

Remember the Lodge is financially sound; the Trustees, Officers, and Manager have been trying to work out ways to keep it that way and at the same time keep your lodge's quality service, THANK YOU members, spouses, and widows for understanding and being patient while we continue to make changes, work out the details, and resolve the issues at hand.
