All the final reports for our Promise, Beacon, and Gratitude Grants have been submitted. We have applied for the Freedom Grant to be used for the community Veteran's Day meal. Have also applied for the Anniversary Grant, the funds for this grant will be used to help the food pantry, the shop with a cop program, and the animal shelter. Our Promise Grant again this year will be used to help purchase Christmas gifts for the children of soldiers in the Wounded Warrior Battalion and the Geary County Fishing Derby. Currently working on our Gratitude Grant application. Funds from this grant will be used for the Pacesetter Christmas party and pool party. Will also allocate funds for the Boy Scouts to help send scouts to camp and to help new scouts get involved.

## **SCHOLARSHIPS:**

### **MVS:**

Most Valuable Student scholarships will be available on line Sept. 1<sup>st</sup>. Deadline for submission is Nov. 27<sup>th</sup>. The Elks National Foundation will award 500 four-year scholarships. Locally we will award up to 6 one-year scholarships. There will also be several scholarships awarded by the state.

Any high school senior who is a citizen of the United States is eligible to apply. Male and female students compete separately.

### **Legacy Awards:**

Legacy awards are \$4,000 scholarships for children & grandchildren of Elks members. There are a total of 300 awards. Online applications are available Sept 1<sup>st</sup> and the deadline is Feb. 2<sup>nd</sup>.

### **Emergency Educational Grants:**

This program provides financial assistance to children of deceased or totally disabled Elks.


