

The price of pizza increased to \$8.50. but we also brought back Jack's for those that wanted a thin crust.

The cost of hotdogs has increased through our food suppliers, so we've made a slight change. The cost of hotdogs will remain at \$5.00, but chips will now be an extra cost.

We have added Nacho and cheese at a cost of \$4.00, and we will add a \$.50 bump if they want the cheese on any other food.

Dining Room Dinner Procedures

A change in the Dining Room beginning June 1st All meals must be served by 6:30 PM, with purchase hours from 4:30 PM to 6:00 PM. And we will no longer have waitstaff for Tuesday night dinners. This adjustment is intended to reduce paid staff hours and generate cost savings.

Weekly Draw

The Weekly Draw has resumed and has rolled over each week. The pot is growing.

Lottery Board

The May Lottery Board is now posted and will be drawn on May 31st.

And the Kentucky Derby party was a success even with the challenge we faced. The Bar proceeds were \$2,020, which doubled from last year and the Lodge \$602 from the raffles, 50/50 and games played.

The Lodge is now accepting applications for enclosed trailer storage. To qualify, trailers must be fully insured, registered, and in good condition. Storage is available exclusively to Elk members who will be required to complete the necessary paperwork in the office. The fee is \$100 per month.
