Run For The Wall® (also known as RFTW) is an organized cross-country motorcycle ride to honor our veterans, their families and friends, and to raise awareness of those still missing – our Prisoners of War (POW) and those Missing in Action (MIA).

Cumberland County is on the Midway Route which runs from May 13th to May 23rd. We are looking for people to support and to watch the RFTW group (over 250 motorcycles) when they come through Crossville. The anticipated time the Run will be coming through Crossville is on May 20th at 9:45 am. It is advisable to be there no later than 9:30.
