The cost of this event would have been over \$2,200, we only had \$1,100 left from our grant. Todd Godfrey, owner of Godfrey's matched our funds. The soldiers were invited to the Lodge for some fellowship. They were treated to a delicious meal prepared by Bonnie Bradshaw and Vonnie Bryant. They played, pool, darts, cards and visited with several of our members. Dewey Terrill was on hand to take some pictures and do an interview.

Scout Master for Troop 64, Linda Vann-Owens and several scouts were presented a check for \$400 to help them purchase camping gear. The donation was made possible through our Elks National Foundation Gratitude Grant. Also, a donation was made to Sally Mayes for Friends of Animals

I encourage you to include a donation to ENF along with your dues. I know it is easier to just pay the amount shown on the notice and not add any additional costs. But we depend on the Grants that are available to us to help our community. As we give to ENF the Grants across the board will increase. An example is the Freedom Grant, it will increase from \$2,000 to \$2,500. If 15% of our membership donates, then we are eligible for a \$500 increase for the Gratitude Grant. Sometimes an entirely new grant is added.
