Dear Members,

Like so many of our Members, I am also a member of many other organizations. It seems as if people are constantly asking for charitable donations. This leads to having to make decisions on who to support this month and who can wait until next month. I mention this because I attended the PA Elks Convention this past week at Seven Springs Resort and again was overwhelmed by Our Home Service Program. If you are not aware of what this program provides here are a few highlights. There are twenty two nurses who provide home health care across our state to families with severely handicapped family members. The Home Services Program provides not only the nurses pay, but each nurse also requires an automobile and other requisite needs.

At the convention I had the honor of representing the Butler Members and making our final Home Service donation for the year. Each year we are asked to reach our Per Capita goal of \$10. This year Our Lodge of 676 Members donated a total of \$8495.99 for a per capita average of \$12.57. The total donated by the statewide Elks was in excess of \$501,000, all of which goes into keeping the wonderful program in operation.

Please keep this in mind when you receive our requests for donations for the Home Services Program. It is essential that we maintain this program and all the good it does.

We are planning our annual Elks Family Picnic and would like to have some volunteers step forward to serve on the committee.
