When you click the link you will come to the general information page, please fill this out completely as this is the information necessary to secure your FREE registration for the convention. Remember to read and click agree on the Waiver form at the very bottom of the Sign Up page. IF you are signing up a non member spouse or other non member volunteer please use YOUR Lodge and YOUR membership number for the Guest registration. On the next page are descriptions of the various roles and responsibilities. Please take time to read each one carefully and then you may check as many as you like however you must check at least 1 role in the box to the right to move to the next page. The third page is a calendar where you will select your available days and times that we may schedule your shifts from once they are actually available. You can select various times OR just click the available ALL DAY on the right. There are several responsibilities that will take place the week before the convention for those coming up early but the main dates to look at are Friday June 28th thru July 3rd. Finally the 4th page is the Completed Registration Page with a general message. Moving forward email will be the primary source of contact and you will be receiving updates starting with an initial acceptance email once your registration has been verified. Actual shifts will be created (probably first quarter 2024) and you will be notified in plenty of time to make you hotel reservations.
