

Hello to all,



We have experienced increases in Grand Lodge fees that have not been assessed to our members yet and we have also been given notice that their fees, particularly insurance fees, will continue to rise the next 2 years. Our Grand Lodge fees, State fees and District fees total \$29.75 this year, \$34.75 for year ending March, 2024 and expect to be at least \$39.75 ending March, 2025. These fees are sent directly to those entities. With those assessments and the fact our lodge has increased costs in maintenance and utilities, the Board of Directors has proposed an increase to our dues to be effective with the new Elks year beginning April 1, 2023.

This will be voted on at the November 16th meeting. A motion will be made to increase the dues for members to \$125 per year for regular members and \$40 for life members. (Life members typically only pay what is owed per member for Grand Lodge, State and District fees).

Our lodge/club is open 7 days a week with lunch served 6 days and a dinner meal offered 4 nights a week. Many lodges are not open every day and some do not open until 4:00 p.m. so we feel we offer a lot to our members and are happy to do it.

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
