Member Rosalie Grenz visited **Norfolk, NE Lodge #653**. This Lodge is unique as they are located in the local VFW facility along with the AMVETS and Lions Club. No surprise that the lodge focuses heavily on community betterment, youth activities, and veteran support.



Ray Herrick and Cathy Vinas visited **Rochester, NY Lodge #24** situated just south of Rochester in Henrietta, NY. It chartered in 1899 - just 31 years after the founding of the Elks. Their historical importance was cemented in July 1913, when they hosted the national Grand Lodge "Reunion" drawing massive parades and thousands of visitors.



Ed and Patty Langolf visited **Salisbury, NC Lodge #669**. They were chartered in 1901 and pride themselves on supporting the local community, as well as many Elk programs.

Skip Haley visited **Jackson Hole, WY Lodge #1713**. The lodge has a rich local history tied closely tied to Jackson's iconic and uniquely-Wyoming annual "Elk Antler Collection." Were shed elk antlers in the National Elk Refuge are collected by local Boy Scout troops.



Ray Herrick and Cathy Vinas visited **Olean, NY Lodge #491** located in the southern tier area of the state. Much has changed since 1899 when the lodge was instituted. 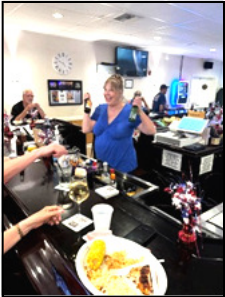

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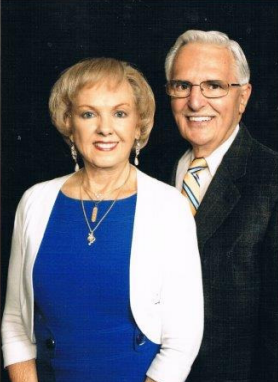
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
