NEW this year the recipients are required to do four hours of volunteering at the Elks. Please make them feel welcome and wish them well in college.

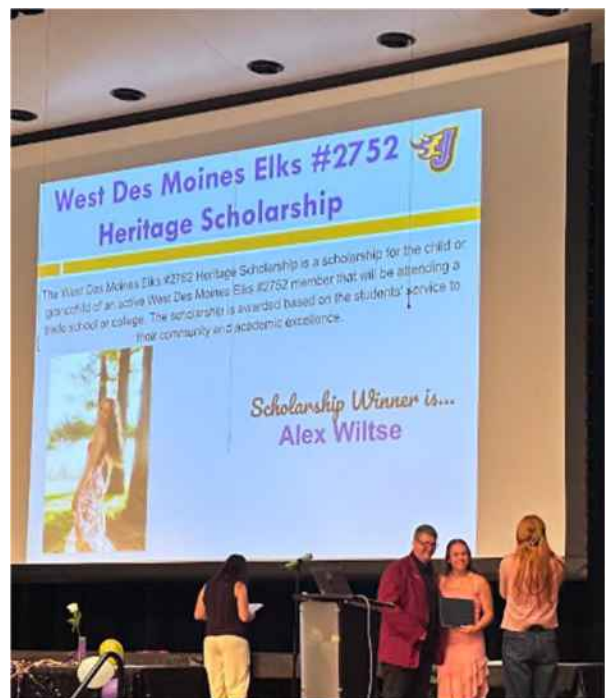

Our lodge continues to be very supportive of the Annual Iowa Elks Association Veterans Home Fish Fry which was held Saturday May 16<sup>th</sup>. Our 9 lodge volunteers met at the Lodge at 8:00am and car pooled up to the home (about an hour drive).

We participated in serving approximately 80 Veteran wheelchair patients who we brought down from their rooms to the dining room, helped serve food, carry trays and clean tables; then take them back to their rooms. There was a total of 62 Iowa Elks Volunteers.

Best of all the Veterans enjoyed the delicious fish fry which included 160 pounds of fried Pollock, which was cooked by Steve Hicks PER and Lisa Widick, both of Perry Lodge #407 and the fish breaded by Ricky Bob of Des Moines Lodge #98. The meal also included baked beans, scalloped potatoes, apple sauce, Jello salads, rolls, coffee, tea, milk or water, and of course ice cream.

All of the above is sponsored by the Iowa Elks Association, prepared, cooked and served by Iowa Elks from many Lodges. The Marshalltown Veterans Home is currently the residence of approximately 374 Iowa Veterans and spouses.

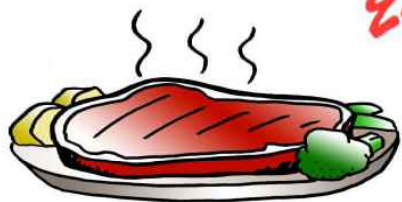
