# EXALTED RULER



Hello Again, Elks Family!

I know we talk a lot about how we need more members (and we do!) but I wanted to focus this month on what this Lodge is amazing at.

I got home yesterday from the CHEA (California-Hawaii Elks Association) State Convention. If you've never been to one of these conventions, I highly recommend it. You get to spend three days with Elks from all over the state and learn about the amazing work that our State Association has been doing over the last year.

On the last day of the convention there is something called the Exalted Ruler's Piggy Bank March, where the Exalted Ruler from each of the 176 Lodges in California and Hawaii go on stage and announce how much their Lodge raised in total for CHEMPI as well as the per capita. Our Lodge along with Emblem Club #178 raised a total of \$16,104.38 with a per capita of \$75.61. I could not have been prouder of our Lodge. We might not have as many members as the other Lodges, but this was one of the highest Per Capita amounts in the state.

Our entire District also had an exceptional year, raising a remarkable \$298,923.44 in support of CHEMPI. Even more impressive, Lodges across the state came together to raise an astounding **\$4.8 million** for the Major Project. That all goes towards funding 32 paid therapists and preschool vision screeners to Help Kids Walk, Talk, See, and Play.

These numbers represent more than just dollars raised. They reflect the compassion and commitment of our members to supporting children with disabilities. Every raffle ticket bought, donation made, and event volunteered helped to make this achievement possible.

These accomplishments are a testament to the spirit of Elkdom and the belief that, working together, we truly can make a difference in the lives of others. Well done, everyone. This is something our Lodge can truly be proud of.
