

## NOTES FROM AROUND THE LODGE

### PER's

The Great Wall will be closing down before Thanksgiving so we will try the Patio next. Same time just a slightly different station. We've met there before and the members liked it. Our evening meeting was a big success. Lots of interaction and enthusiasm. Our December Senior Citizen Supper should be something new and beneficial for our community.

### TRUSTEES

Still working on trying to cut expenses on things within the Club and Lodge. We pulled 8 - 300 watt bulbs from recesses within the ceiling. (That is 2.4 kw of electricity anytime they are on). The bulbs were ancient and incandescent so they generated lots of heat and not too much light. Bulbs like that change color temperature as they age. In the old days when we used 2000 watt photo bulbs they only held their color temperature for about 10 hours. Tried replacing the bulbs with 100 watt equivalent LED daylight bulbs. Those took about 148 watts of energy (for all 8). Early reports indicated that was not enough light so we will be replacing 4 of them with 200 watt equivalent daylight LED's. That should still not quite equal the electricity used by one of the old incandescent bulbs.

### HEALTH

Hate to sound like everyone else but the flu shots are important. None of us want to get the stuff then pass it on to someone who has a compromised immune or respiratory system.

Also watching this new flaccid myelitis. Reminds me a lot of the news in the late 40's and early 50's before Dr. Jonas Salk started the testing on kids in 1952. We weren't allowed into movie theaters or swimming pools while the outbreaks were in full swing (summer). Frankly we went to the movies for the air conditioning, and there was no way we'd go to outdoor swimming pools in the fall and winter. Thank you Dr. Salk. Be extra careful in protecting your families.

### VETERANS

We are getting ready for the Vets Supper on Sunday November 11, 2018. It has been a rough year for older local Vets. I know I won't remember all the names but we all lost close friends to the last bugle call this year. Dan Granzella, Dan Johnson, Herb Taylor, and so many others. This year we will have George Blake tell us about the period leading up to December 7, 1941 in Hawaii. I have had many friends who were in the military when WWII broke out. I never did tire of hearing their stories. If you can help, Karen and I will start setting up at about 1:00 P.M. and will be happy for any help available. Doors will open at 5:30 P.M. and the POW/MIA presentation will start things up.

### A QUICK TIP

Quick patch for pneumonia holes in windows? Super glue a cheap piece of glass from a cheap frame to the window. Use packing tape for a clamp if it is cold. Only try this if you know you will have to replace the window glass.
