We received the Gratitude Grant funds for 2019 that we secured for BACA (Bikers Against Child Abuse), The check presentation was done at the last meeting on May 27, 2019. After the members of BACA related their interactions with several abused children (anonymously) many lodge members had a few tears in their eyes. This group is so supportive of abused children. We wish the organization did not have to exist, but are very thankful that they are there to support these children. Since BACA members do not use their real names, thank you to Lone Wolf, Boo Boo Bear and Berger for all that you are doing for these children.

We have finalized the year end reports for the lodge with the Elks Grand Lodge. We have had to pay dollars to the IRS for the bar sales to the public so our accountant has asked that we separate the member sales from the non-member sales. I have this all separated on the I-pad that we use at the bar so next year our IRS tax will be much lower. Even though we are tax exempt as the lodge, we have to pay income tax on the sales to non-members.


