The **2021 MOST VALUABLE STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP** competition opened August 5, 2020. Current high school seniors who are U.S. citizens and plan to attend a 4 year accredited American university are eligible to apply. Applicants do not need to be related to an Elk member. Applicants will be judged on scholarship, leadership, and financial need. All applications are done on-line. Apply at elks.org/scholarships/mvs.cfm. **The deadline to apply is November 15, 2020 at 11:59 Pacific Time.** Applicants are judged at the local level first. Our lodge awards 3 females and 3 males a \$1000 scholarship and these applicants go on to district and state competition. The Elks National Foundation allocated 2.9 million dollars and will award 500 four-year scholarships to the top-rated applicants nationwide.

***THE EMERGENCY EDUATIONAL GRANT provides undergraduate college financial assistance to children of deceased or totally disabled Elks in the form of renewable, one-year grants of up to \$5,000. The student must attend an accredited U.S. college or university full time (12 semester hours), show financial need, be unmarried and under the age of 23 as on December 31st in the year of application. Applications are available by request between May 1 and October 31 of the academic year for which assistance is desired.
