#### Swimming Pool Update

We attempted to have a Pool Committee meeting to set up to run the Pool for the summer on Wednesday, April 28th. Three members attended the meeting. With this amount of participation, it would not be fair to those few members if we were to try to open and staff the pool/Tiki Hut for the summer.

The Board of Directors met on Monday night, May 3<sup>rd</sup>, after the regularly scheduled Lodge meeting. The opening of the pool was discussed. <u>The Board would like to see the pool and Tiki Hut opened</u> but **all agree that assistance from the <u>members who use and enjoy the pool</u> is required to make this happen.** 

Please understand:

- Pool Hours are 10:00 AM to 8:00 PM (except on Mondays).
  - All posted pool rules continue enforce.
- To purchase a pool pass (\$125.00 for summer 2021), all Lodge dues must be current.
- To use a pool pass for entry into the pool, **the member or their spouse must be present** with a current membership card (or spouse's card).
- Guest fees will be enforced this year.
  - Adults who enjoy the pool as guests of members, after 3 visits, should be asked to join the Lodge as members.
- A signup sheet will be posted to help with cleaning the pool **once** per week.
  - Vacuuming the pool and trash removal to the dumpster takes approximately 3-4 hours.
  - Vacuuming the pool should be done prior to opening the pool at 10:00 AM, to be able to see what needs to be cleaned.
  - It is best that vacuuming be completed toward the end of the week for the pool to be clean for Saturday and Sundays.
- We are required to staff the Tiki Hut with volunteers and will ask for persons to sign up and work a four or eight hour shift on Saturdays and Sundays each weekend.
  - If no one signs up and works the Tiki Hut will be closed.
  - Volunteers may ask to see a membership card along with a pool pass when coming to the pool. Understand the volunteer may not know who you are and they are doing as asked.
  - Volunteers working a shift are in charge and their requests should be complied with.
- Tiki Hut shifts are from 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM and 2:00 PM to 6:00 PM.
- **No alcoholic beverages may be brought into the pool** due to our ABC license requirements.
  - Members and /or guests who are found with alcohol not purchased from the Club (Tiki Hut) will be asked to surrender their membership card and leave the premises. The member may then come to the next House Committee on Monday evenings to seek the return of their membership card.
  - When the Tiki Hut is open, you are expected to patronize the Tiki Hut for your snacks and drinks, etc. Do **not** bring in food/drinks during the hours the Tiki Hut is open.
  - $\circ$   $\;$  Alcoholic beverages purchased at the Tiki Hut must be consumed at the pool.
  - When the Tiki Hut is closed there should be no alcoholic beverages at the pool.
  - You may continue to bring food/soft drinks/water when the Tiki Hut is closed.
- The Pool will be **closed on Mondays** for treating the water.

The above is essentially how the pool/Tiki Hut has operated for the past several years but the Board of Directors note that it has been increasingly difficult to secure volunteers to operate the pool. Your cooperation is expected.
