Happy Thanksgiving!

Hard to believe that Thanksgiving is just around the corner. As busy

as the Lodge has been, time is just flying by.

Our Lodge received two Elks National Foundation (ENF) Grants for the Veterans Center and Virgin Valley Food Bank. We presented the Vets Center a check for \$3,500 and the Food Bank a check for \$2,500. At this time of year these funds help to support our community. These grants are only part of the programs ENF supports. Most Valuable Student is a scholarship program that can fund your child or grandchild's college education. ENF provides grant money to the Elks State organizations throughout the country. Our Lodge recently received funds from Nevada State Elks Association (NSEA) that we are using to purchase dictionaries for the 3rd grade classes at our local elementary schools. These funds will also be used to assist with the Shop with a Cop program. ENF provides so much for so many with the donations we make as a Lodge and as individuals. Last month we held a Paint with Wine event, we donated the funds to ENF. We give a little and get a lot back. This year our Lodge has been able to donate \$18,000 to our community through grants!

We have our NSEA mid-term meeting in Las Vegas November 18-21. The Grand Exalted Ruler, T Keith Mill will be attending. We will not have a Lodge meeting on the 18th, but we will have orientation and initiation on November 10th at 5:00 pm.

Our next Building Expansion Town Hall on November 13th at 10 am.

#### **Additional House Rule**

5. Bartenders have complete discretion as to whether to continue serving alcoholic beverages to Lodge patrons including but not limited to a Member, Associate Member, the guest of either a Member or Associate Member, or members of the public who may be attending an event hosted by the lodge or as part of an event for which the Lodge facilities are being used. A decision by a bartender to discontinue or "cut-off" the service of alcoholic beverages to a Lodge patron carries with it the full authority and backing of the House Committee and the Board of Directors. Should the Member patron disagree with the bartender's decision, the member will not argue the issue with the bartender buy may instead submit in writing or in person their complaint to the House Committee at the next regularly scheduled meeting. It should be understood that arguing with the bartender or general disorderly conduct may subject the offending member to disciplinary action including suspension of club privileges.
