#### Trunk-or-Treat

On Halloween, Sunday, October 31, 2021, the Green Bay Elks Lodge along with Cub Scout Pack 4163 and ScoutsBSA (Boy Scouts) Troop 1363, held their 3<sup>rd</sup> annual Trunk-or-Treat event. This was the biggest effort that we have put together yet, and this was the biggest turn out that we have ever gotten. For this years Trunk-or-Treat event, we were able to get about 20 families to decorate their trunks and hand out candy, along with a giant bounce house that was

a huge hit with the kids. Then inside the lodge, we offered hotdogs, 144 of them, they went fast. The hotdogs were donated from Salm Partners. We also offered hot apple cider, two different photo booths, indoor Halloween themed yard games, and of course the haunted hallway, inside door-to-door trick-or-treating. During the event it was awesome to see how many families showed up and stayed for a while, all while more families kept showing up, what a great issue to have. After talking to the Elks and Scouts that were there at the event, we came up with an estimated 275 – 300 people visited the lodge for this Trunk-or-Treat event.
