From your Esteem Lecturing Knight; Dennis P. Fitzgerald USA, Ret To all my Fellow Lodge Members;

After an arduous research session and discussions with Elks from other Lodges and States, I have the correct procedure for us when we render a salute to our national colors.

1<sup>st</sup> - for Veterans it is simple, we salute by rendering the proper military hand salute. That is: right hand raised to our forehead just above the right eyebrow, with our Elbow at 45° bend.

2<sup>nd</sup>: for all other it is the placement of the right hand over your heart, with your right Thumb, folded into your palm. No Matter, how you place your right hand over your heart, either w/thumb folded into your palm or flat against your index finger, please just do it.

# MEMORIAL DAY CELEBRATION

Memorial Day is an American holiday, observed on the last Monday of May, honoring the men and women who died while serving in the U.S. military.

Originally known as Decoration Day, it originated in the years following the Civil War and became an official federal holiday in 1971. Many Americans observe Memorial Day by visiting cemeteries or memorials, holding family gatherings and participating in parades. Unofficially, it marks the beginning of the summer season.

For decades, Memorial Day continued to be observed on May 30, the date General Logan had selected for the first Decoration Day. But in 1968, Congress passed the Uniform Monday Holiday Act, which established Memorial Day as the last Monday in May in order to create a three-day weekend for federal employees. The change went into effect in 1971. The same law also declared Memorial Day a federal holiday.
