Future Planning Committee – Major Projects

We would like to provide updates on the various Future Planning Committee projects. The parking lot work is just about completed. You will notice the pilings have been set in place. The last steps will be to install rope in-between to finish the nautical theme, which will be completed the first week of June. Again, this effort was undertaken to provide a visual barrier to stop vehicles from running into the ditch at the end of the parking area. Parking spot lines will be the final step, later in June.

The four (4) camp ground spots at the back of the property have been identified and cut in. The next steps will be to to remove debris from the area, level the area, apply crushed stone and seed the dirt areas. If any member has access to crushed stone we sure could use a favorable price!!!

In the next week work will begin on the installation of a new wood fence. This fence will replace the old, worn out fencing in the back area and the fence along the south side of the building. Work is expected to take 7-10 days.

The final project is to bring electrical and water service from the building to the elk statue in the front of the building. The Elk's want to thank Rob Hilton for his commitment to volunteer to do all the plumbing work!!! Thank you Rob!!! What we need is an electrician to support this effort. We would love an Elk to volunteer their time, but would also appreciate a "good price" to make it happen.
