"The Secretary shall, no fewer than seven (7) days immediately prior to balloting, either:


a) mail notice in writing to all members of the Lodge, giving the name and city and state of each applicant, his business, the name of his proposer and the date when action may be taken upon the application, OR

Greetings, hope this letter finds you well. We all know that this past year has been rough on all of us. With the grace of God and the help of all Elks members, volunteers, and community organizations we have managed to keep our lodge open. As we slowly start to move forward with fully opening our lodge for meetings, evening meals, and private gatherings, it is also time for repairs. As a member of the Board and under the direction of the Exalted Ruler Michael Gilligan I am writing this letter requesting your help.

Having one of the largest and oldest Elks Lodge in the area, our building is in desperate need of attention. One of those rooms that really needs attention is the women's restrooms located near the Moreno Room. As many of you women know, the stalls are small, the interior is out dated, and the plumbing is in need of serious attention.

The current pandemic has severely ham pered our ability to serve the members and the community and to raise the needed funds to maintain our building. Your Executive Board has set a goal of \$35,000 for the remodeling of the Women's and Men's restrooms located near the Moreno Room. This amount is based on current bids we have obtained. Changes to the restrooms will be larger stalls, removing one stall, new flooring, mirrors, sinks, paint and tile.


