Bo is a 12 year old boy with a medical diagnosis of spastic quadriplegic cerebral palsy. People with spastic CP have increased muscle tone. This means their muscles are stiff all the time, making it difficult for them to control their body to produce


functional movements. Bo has involvement of all four limbs. Bo is unable to do things typical of kids his age. With the help of an adult or a

walking device, he can walk short distances. While at home he is able to crawl around in order to get from room to room. Due to the spasticity, which causes the stiffness in his muscles, Bo has difficulty straightening his legs and arms. We work weekly in therapy treatments to stretch his extremities to help maintain range of motion in his joints, and strengthening activities to improve independence with simple daily tasks.


