

Please remember that we support ENF and Major Projects. Our Major Projects is cerebral palsy; we help many families who are living with this. ENF supports many things such as hoop shoot, scholarships, and grants, of which Newark has received many to benefit our community. Your yearly donations to ENF make these grants possible. Recently the Newark Elks Lodge obtained a Gratitude Grant from ENF in the amount of \$2500. \$1500 was given to the Humane Society of Wayne County for their senior spay/neuter program and the remaining \$1000 was given to the Alex Eligh Community Center to help support their youth baseball/softball program.

Members contributed \$1,754.00 to ENF last fiscal year and \$800.00 to Major Projects. So, thank you - and please keep up the good work!

ELKS CARE - ELKS SHARE

There are collection boxes at our Lodge for the Humane Society, the VA, and the Food Closet. We have members who will deliver the items to these organizations. The Humane Society of Wayne County is working with Meals on Wheels to deliver pet food to pets in need. They are requesting small bags of dog and cat food (dry food only). Please consider donating to 1 or more of these organizations.

DUES ARE DUE

April 1st, 2023 is the beginning of the Elks fiscal year with that DUES are due April 1, 2023. Grand Lodge will be increasing each Lodge's Per Capita by \$5.00 per person. The State Per Capita is also increasing by \$2.00 per person. It will be necessary for each members dues to increase to \$102.00 for regular members and to \$72.00 per person for Life members.

The 200 Club will now cost a total of \$166.
