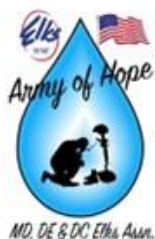

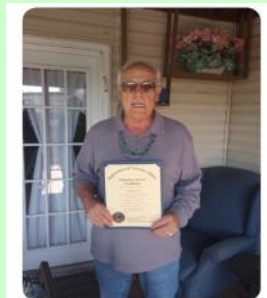

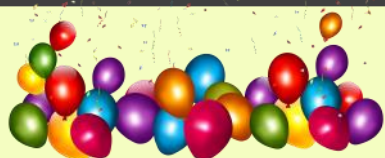

NEWS from the Grants Committee

Final reports Are Done! In 2022, the Grants Committee successfully received four grants totaling **\$12,500**. Final reports for the **Beacon Grant** (Thanksgiving Dinners - \$4,000) and the **Freedom Grant** (special meals for veterans at the VA CLC nursing home - \$3,000) have been submitted and approved. We just completed and await approval of final reports for the **Spotlight Grant** (Welcome Home Kits for Veterans - \$2,000) and the **Gratitude Grant** (Pleasantville School Food Pantry - \$3,500).

We have already re-applied for the **Freedom Grant** to continue to provide special occasion meals and pizza parties to the elderly veterans at the VA nursing home. Applications were due on April 20 with decisions to be announced in mid-May. This is a competitive grant: nationwide, only 200 lodges will be approved. So, cross your fingers! We hope to announce a successful application in next month's News & Views!

Meanwhile, I will be providing updates on this year's grant activity. In the coming weeks, the committee will be looking at our options for the Gratitude, Beacon and Spotlight grants and how to apply for and best use these grants for the betterment of our community and to help our veterans.

Grants Committee members are Paul Amundsen, J.R. Biddison, Pat Clarke, Michelle Rhoads, Bob McIntyre and Anita Viola. Many other Elk members make these community projects a success through their volunteer efforts and contributions to the Elk National Foundation.

And finally, let's all remember: *'Charity is the greatest of all virtues.'*

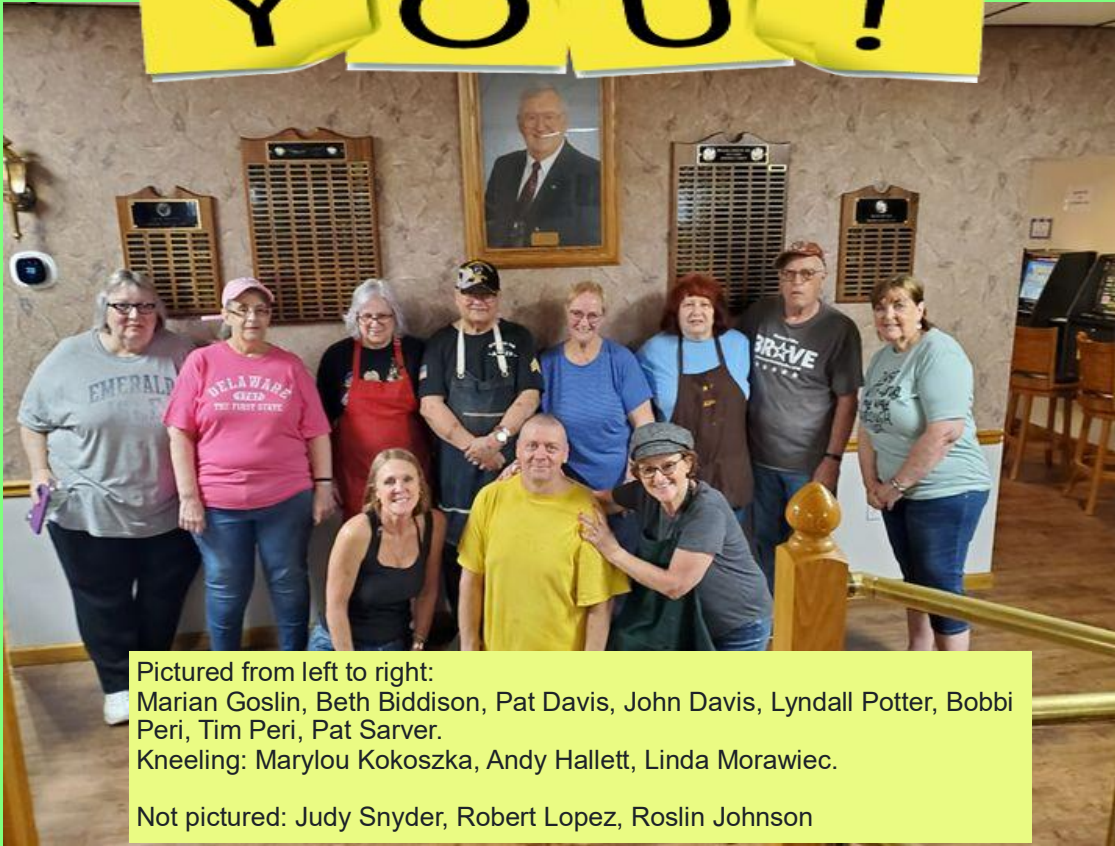
Opening Act:
