SUGGESTION BOX RESPONSE

I want to thank those members who took the opportunity to reach out to me via the new Suggestion Box recently installed in the Lodge Clubroom. I appreciate your input and want to work together with you to achieve a mutually beneficial solution.

Several of the suggestions pertained to the temperature within the Lodge being too cold. I am sure that many of us have encountered this same dilemna at other venues....offices, restaurants, churches. Whenever there is a wide variety of ages present at a location, there is going to be difficulty accommodating the temperature preferences of everyone. Though we strive to achieve a median temperature that will accommodate the majority, there are situations that arise which call for immediate adjustments to be made to AC or heating settings – large crowds at an event...very hot/humid external conditions or conversely very cold external conditions. At those times, it is necessary to adjust the Lodge HVAC up or down

I would like to offer the following as a potential solution to those members who consistently feel cold while at the Lodge: We will clear out a portion of the Clubroom closet and invite members to deposit an extra coat and/or light blanket for their personal use if needed. Each item should include the owners name.

I hope this solution will be a reasonable remedy and a means to make all members and guests comfortable when at the Lodge.


