Outgoing Grand Exalted Ruler Bruce Hidley led the General Sessions each morning. Breakout sessions were available every afternoon covering topics from Elks National Foundation to the My Elks app.

Reports of the Grand Lodge Committees were presented. 18 Resolutions were presented to membership with only 14 passing following voting. All lodges were encouraged to keep this momentum going in the 2023-2024 Elk year for 3 straight years of membership growth.

Finally, we said good-bye to Bruce Hidley for leading the Elks over the last year. Randy P. Shook, Lawrenceburg, TN Lodge No. 2206, was elected as Grand Exalted Ruler for the 2023–2024 year. 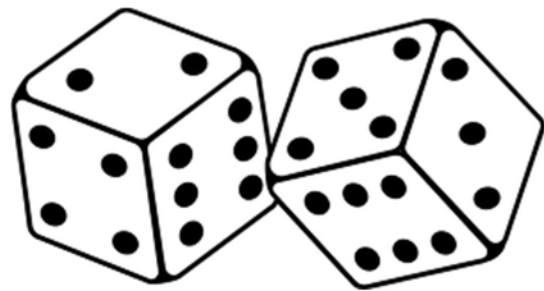

On August 23, 2014 our only child Zachary Michael Paulsen, was murdered on the property in front of our family business. Zach was diagnosed with autism at a young age but was high functioning and living a full life, having graduated from WyoTech with a degree in Diesel Technology.

To honor Zach's memory, we established the Zach Paulsen Memorial Scholarship fund for students with autism disorders who want to attend a technical or trade school. To date we have awarded 14 scholarships.
