
#### Gary Black and the **Playboys**

#### From the Trustees

We are moving right along and have been making some great progress with building repairs and maintenance. Since we last reported. we've had electricians in the building helping us get some much needed updates and repairs completed. We now have new LED lights installed in the kitchen; the lights on the roof have been repaired and are illuminating the building engraving B.P.O. Elks No. 446, the lodge room lights are being repaired; the HVAC system in the front entry is now up and running; the lights in the old coat room are now functional; and additional outlets have been added for use at our new cabinet/serving station. If you haven't had the opportunity to do so, I encourage you to take a drive past the lodge after dark, it looks FANTASTIC and alive again! All of these repairs have been funded by generous donations from our members.

We are also pleased to announce that we have been able to secure a grant from the Bloomington Health Foundation that allowed us to place an order for an Automated External Defibrillator (AED) to help our lodge be better prepared to aid members who may suffer a medical emergency. While the grant did not cover 100% of the cost, it did make the purchase immediately possible. Once the AED is received, we will put out a notice to do a training session with interested members.
