## Around the Lodge By: Rich Stapf Sr.

If you saw the Echo last month, you would have seen that a lot of tasks got completed. With a successful work party day, the putting greens being thoroughly cleaned and other items which are still a work in progress, it was busy.

There is now a 65" TV over the bar. Don White, Nick Rodriguis, Jim Layo and I replaced badly worn out boards on the deck. A thorough evaluation was conducted of the deck and it's under structure. The support structure was found to be in great shape, but the surface has outlived its usable life. We concluded the decking would need to be entirely replaced this year which started us down a path of fund raising. After initial contact for pricing, Arrow Lumber stepped up with a great price for the lodge for all weather decking materials. Based on the very large size of the lodge's deck, \$10,000 or more would be needed to complete the project.

After receiving the estimate for materials, I jumped quick into fund raising the old fashion way. I made phone calls to friends, relatives, lodge members and other donors and within a few short weeks, we were able to secure the funds necessary to make this happen. It's hard to put into words how thrilled I am at how our members stepped up when the need was brought to them.

With the project now loosely slated to begin after the Labor Day Holiday, the next request of our membership is to get a list of capable volunteers together. "We can do it" is our working motto for the deck project. Please join us in making it happen.

Additional funds are greatly appreciated. Although we've raised enough to cover the all weather decking and installation hardware, there's always incidental costs that pop up. Please consider making a donation to the lodge's major maintenance fund and note that it's for the deck project. If it isn't used on the deck, there's a lot of paint which needs to be purchased in the coming years to repaint the building. "We can do it!"
