ENF supports many things such as hoop shoot, scholarships, youth activities, veterans' outreach and grants, of which Newark has received many to benefit our community. In March the Newark Elks Lodge obtained a Gratitude Grant from ENF in the amount of \$2500. \$1500 was given to the Humane Society of Wayne County for their senior spay/neuter program and the remaining \$1000 was given to the Alex Eligh Community Center to help support their youth sports program.


