

The Elks National Foundation (ENF) has kicked off the 2024 scholarship year. Here are the details!

Most Valuable Student (MVS) Contest:

The 2024 MVS application is now open. Applications can be found online at **enf.elks.org/MVS**. The application deadline is November 13, 2023.

The Elks National Foundation (ENF) awards 500 four-year scholarships based on academics, leadership, and financial need. National awards range from \$1000 per year to \$7500 per year. The national awards will be announced in April 2024.

MVS scholarships are for students pursuing a four-year degree on a full-time basis (minimum of 12 semester hours), at a U.S. college or university next school year. Some important applicant details include:

* Current high school seniors (or equivalent) who are citizens of the United States are eligible to apply.

* Applicants do not have to be related to a member of the Elks.

* Male and female students compete separately.

Applicants are selected from a list of the Lodges closest to their home address zip code. Please have students choose Port Townsend Lodge #317 as their sponsoring Lodge. Complete details can be found at enf.elks.org/MVS.

Legacy Awards - The Legacy Awards program begins on September 1, 2023. Legacy Awards provide \$4000 scholarships for children and grandchildren of dues-paying Elk members. The ENF offers a total of 350 national awards. The application deadline is February 5, 2024. Please visit **enf.elks.org/Leg** for more details and the application link.


