With the age of our building additional maintenance items need to be addressed. The entire exterior needs tuck pointing, and a water leak has occurred in the basement dining room ceiling that needs addressed. Insurance will cover a portion of the dining room ceiling, but the \$2500.00 deductible will be our responsibility. These are repairs that cannot be delayed. In total \$17,500 is needed for these repairs.

Over the years the Officers and Trustees have continued to maintain and make improvements to the building and grounds. The porch roof has been totally replaced, new sidewalks installed in the east yard, replacement of air-conditioning in the lodge room, new ceiling tile and lights in the club and lodge room. In the east yard there is a new concrete stage, new tables and chairs, an outside bar building, new fencing, and outdoor lighting. This has all been done thanks to the support of our members.

In addition, over the past 6 – 7 years your membership dues and ENF support has made it possible for us to give over \$28,000 in grants to local charitable groups and over \$63,000 in scholarships to local students.

The Elks National Foundation (ENF) has kicked off the 2023 scholarship year. Here are the details!

Attention SENIORS and parents of Seniors: The lowa State Elks Association is pleased to offer twenty (20) \$1,500.00 Vocational Grants to individuals pursuing a vocational (2-year or less) training/educational program. These grants are open to current high school seniors or any non-traditional student (second career, etc.) pursuing such a program at an accredited school. These grants ARE NOT intended for students who will pursue a 4-year course of study eventually leading to a bachelor's degree; this includes students attending a community college with the intent of continuing on to a four-year degree program. Applications received for persons ultimately pursuing a 4-year course of study will be disqualified from consideration. The application deadline is MARCH 6, 2023.

You may apply online at www.elks.org, follow the instructions carefully (as of this writing, the application was not yet on the website, but should be added shortly). I will also have some applications printed for the entryway of the lodge.

Legacy Awards

The Legacy Awards program begins on September 1, 2022. Legacy Awards provide \$4,000 scholarships for children and grandchildren of dues-paying Elk members.
