LOUNGE CHAIR CHALLENGE



Members of the Project Update Committee, Glenda Bliss, Gwen Klammer, Steve Impson, Paul Nutting, and Wayne Page, are currently researching new chairs for the lounge. Requirements for the chairs are that they have arms and wheels, can swivel and material is an industrial strength vinyl.

However, it is first necessary to raise the funds to buy the chairs. It is hoped to keep the cost of a chair at \$250. Estimated funding would be \$15,000 (\$250 a chair X 60 chairs).

Thanks to a \$500 donation from Past Exalted Ruler, Marie Vesta, and an additional \$280 from Sunday's events we have a starting balance of \$780.

It is a beginning, but we are going to need our members help in researching acceptable replacement chairs and, of course, in paying for the chairs. A progress chart will be placed on the bulletin board.
