Elks Beacon Grant \$2000 Awarded to 4PA "A clean & safe community for all"

Our Lodge awarded a community grant of \$2000 to 4PA. We presented the check to their Founder, Joe Descala at their 2 year Anniversary event held in our Ballroom on November 4th, 2023.

Started in November 2021, 4PA operates a full-time crew to clean-up abandoned homeless encampments and illegal dump sites. They also monitor these areas weekly, so they don't get utilized again. This work is done in conjunction with a variety of other city agencies that they've established relationships with and within the parameters of the law.

To date so far, they've removed over 145,000 pounds of material from our public spaces, natural areas and surrounding properties. They've removed debris from Peabody Creek, Tumwater Creek, Olympic


Discovery Trail, Cherry Hill, land near the fairgrounds, 8th Street Bridge areas and even downtown Port Angeles. They were even awarded the 2022 "Organization of the Year" for their accomplishments.
