Fellow Members.

The Lodge has certainly been very active over the summer months! We again have many activities and functions planned for the upcoming Holiday season, and hope that you can find a few to your liking to come to the Lodge and support.

I would briefly like to remind you of a few of our House Committee rules as we have been lax in enforcing and have noticed some un-Elk like behavior recently.

House Rules

The following rules are set forth and enforced by the House Committee of the Frackville Elks Lodge No. 1533:

- All members will be governed at all times by Grand Lodge Statutes, Lodge By-Laws, and House Rules. Any member bringing guests will be held responsible for their conduct and compliance with these House Rules. House Rules are in effect any time you and your guests are on Lodge property.
- No admittance or service will be provided unless your dues are current, and paid in full, for the Lodge year.
- Any member in good standing wishing to extend the courtesy of the Lodge to their spouse; (or to the widow of a deceased member) may do so by request to the Secretary of the Lodge who will issue an Elks Identification Card. The ID card does not carry the privileges of the Lodge, however, they are for identification and all courtesies of the Lodge will be extended.
- Sexual harassment, using religious or racial slurs, and fighting are not permitted.
- Vile, obscene and insulting language used in an Elks Lodge or club is an offense against the Laws of the Order.
- Bartender, House Committee Member or any Officer may verbally
 warn you for any infraction. Continued bad conduct will result in you
 being asked to leave and may result in a hearing following at least a
 (10) day written notice of alleged violation of club rules or conduct
 unbecoming an Elk committed on club premises.; further action such
 as suspension may result following the results of the meeting.
 Warnings on repetitive occasions may be progressive.
- No smoking tobacco or any type of electronic vaping devices inside the physical Lodge building.
- Illegal gambling is prohibited. Gambling that is held to be illegal by Federal, state or local jurisdictions is a violation under the Statutes of the Order.
- Removal of any property, supplies, furnishings, appliances, or any other equipment is forbidden unless express permission is obtained from Board of Trustees, ER or House Committee chairman.

Frackville Elks Breakfast to Return as Frackville Elks Brunch

We have held breakfast planning meetings, for ANY Elk member interested in volunteering, on Sunday August 20th and Sunday September 17th. We will be holding our next planning meeting on Sunday October 22nd at 6:00 P.M. We still do not have a complete committee of volunteers, and I would love to add a few more helpers to the list. At the next meeting we will further discuss the list of job duties and the ordering of food and supplies.

At our previous meetings, we finalized the menu and the date of our first brunch event, to be held Sunday November 5, 2023 from 9:00 A.M. to 1:00 P.M. Then we will have brunch events every month on the first Sunday of each month through June. The November menu will be as follows: Eggs (made to order), potatoes, toast, bacon, sausage, pancakes, and French toast for breakfast. We will have coffee, tea, and juices available. The cash bar will be open for the following drinks: mimosa, bloody Mary, draft beer, and soda. Our brunch items will be BLTs or BBQ sandwich, with chips, pickles, fruit and cake. The breakfast items on the menu will slightly change month-to-month and the featured brunch items for the next month will be announced at the current brunch event.

Frackville Elks Veterans Service Committee

On Tuesday July 11, 2023, members of the Frackville Elks Lodge's Elks National Veterans Service Commission committee purchased items, assembled eight Welcome Home kits valued at \$2,400 and delivered one of them to a Veteran in need in Pottsville, and the seven others to the Veterans Multi-Service Center in Reading. Welcome Home kits are intended for homeless Veterans or Veterans at risk of homelessness. Elks Lodges across the country help Veterans establish their homes by building and delivering Welcome Home Kits, which generally include some small furniture, kitchenware, and cleaning supplies. Items can be new or used, donated or purchased.



Frackville Elks Local Scholarship Winners

The Frackville Elks Lodge No. 1533 recently established a local scholarship program and selected four award winners for the inaugural year of the program. The criteria for applying for the scholarship includes that the student must be a North Schuylkill senior enrolled in the college preparatory program or attending the Schuylkill Technology Center. There is a focus on academics, attendance, and discipline record, but judges place an extreme focus on the community service record of the student as a major requirement for consideration for the award.
