Iowa State Elks Association Vocational Grants

The Iowa State Elks Association is pleased to offer twenty (20) \$1,500.00 Vocational Grants to individuals pursuing a vocational (2-year or less) training/educational program. These grants are open to current high school seniors or any non-traditional student (second career, etc.) pursuing such a program at an accredited school. These grants ARE NOT intended for students who will pursue a 4-year course of study eventually leading to a bachelor's degree; this includes students attending a community college with the intent of continuing onto a four-year degree program. Applications received for persons ultimately pursuing a 4-year course of study will be disqualified from consideration.
