From Our Secretary's Desk

February is a month of transition for Elks Lodges. This will be the month where our lodge decides on the upcoming year of officers. Nominations will be February 14th and we vote on those nominations on February 28th.

We welcome all members to consider active roles in the Lodge activities and the charities we support. Positions in committees are a great way to start your support. Help is needed in spreading the word of our Activities through the Publicity Committee, Youth activities involving scholarships, essay writing and sports such as Soccer shoot or Hoop Shoots. This is just to name a few and they involve only a few hours of work through the month or year.

It is also a time to renew your membership. New key cards will be needed for April and remember,

delinquent members are not allowed access to the lodge and cannot be signed in as a guest. So, get your renewal in as soon as invoicing comes

You may notice an area on the invoice requesting additional contributions. We have four important categories and request you consider contributions to these special programs. They are for Elks National Foundation (ENF), CT Elks special projects- Hartford Children's Hospital, Scholarships and Range programs. Every year, Glastonbury has a goal of Approximately \$5 per member for ENF, that support allows us to apply for Grants to help Veterans, Food Banks, Centers for Drug and Mental wellness. This is a National program which helps lodges support local efforts. Your contributions have led to over \$10,000 going out locally to food banks in the Hartford area and Intercommunity Health center in East Hartford. CT Elks contributions go to the Safe Kids program at Hartford Hospital as well as

Connecticut's Special Olympics. The Scholarship fund is for Youth programs and used to help support our Camp Sunrise program. Lastly the Range funds are used for Maintenance and upgrades to the Range. Last year a big effort was made to clear overgrowth surrounding the range area. Not to mention, added security with installation of cameras.


