
FROM THE EXALTED RULER Doug McLaughlin



Veterans Report


As we move into the New Year, our veterans committee will continue to support our mission of supporting and helping Veterans!




Coleman White and Pete Smith drop off items for Chemotherapy patients at the Muskogee Veterans Hospital.
