





# Preparing for 2024 Pool Season

The House Committee, Board of Trustees and Pool Committee are ready for summer and excited to reopen our pool for the 2024 season, with big changes ahead.

To keep up with the increasing costs of operating our pool, and in comparing our prices to every other private and public pool in our region, it has been made clear that it is necessary to raise pool pass dues for the 2024 season. This change is effective as of March 1, 2024. We do not take these changes lightly, but in order to maintain our operating costs, and continue to offer members "free" use of the pool, our other passes must increase. The rates are listed below for your pass category.

2024 Pool Pass Pricing
Family Pass = \$275
Spouse/Single Minor Pass = \$100
Daily Pass = \$15
Weekly Visitor Pass = \$75

(RV guests or family visiting for 1 week valid for 7 consecutive days, valid for 1 person)

Elks Member Single Person Pass = FREE

In addition to these changes, there will be no more "free swim" days at the pool. All holidays and picnic days, when the Lodge is open to members and guests, will require pool passes and guest passes to be purchased in order to swim. This is for the safety of our members and guests, and due to capacity concerns.

The pool resurfacing is essential to providing quality facilities, and a safe swimming environment. This has been postponed for too long and is now a necessity and an essential repair. The repair is an emergency priority before we can open the pool for the 2024 season. The resurfacing bids have been presented to the Board. The Board made thier recommendation on the Lodge floor at the last Lodge meeting, as discussed in the last Bugle. At the March 19, 2024 meeting the resurfacing was brought to the lodge floor for discussion and voting; it was approved by the Board and our membership. The pool resurfacing project was approved for forwarding to Grand National Lodge for final approval. The resurfacing will be completed as soon as possible with updates provided throughout the process.

The opening date of the pool and the Polar Plunge will be determined after the timeline for the resurfacing of the pool is confirmed.

Thank you for your support of the House Committee, the Board, and the Pool Committee as we work together to make the 2024 summer season another great one!
