

The Elks year will soon draw to an end and the Veterans Committee wanted to inform everyone that supported our fund raisers throughout the year how we spent our funds.

We were able to participate in "Wreaths Across America" which is a program to purchase wreaths to honor and remember our fallen hero soldiers.

With your help we purchased ten tickets to the Worcester Sharks vs. Norfolk Admirals hockey game and were able to send ten Veterans from Leeds to the game in Worcester on Veterans Appreciation Night,

We also donated to the Thomas Memorial Country Club flags and wreaths to be placed on graves in cemeteries in the Town of Montague.

"Salute to our Veterans" on WHAI and Bear Country which ran June 30th thru July 4th

The VA in Leeds has bowling lanes that vets were unable to use because they were in need of repair and no money for that, we were able to have the lanes repaired for them.

They were in need of a 100 cup coffee pot, we purchased that and coffee.

We go every month for Bingo where we purchase and serve soda and ice cream along with a cash Bingo. Because some of these Veterans are handicapped they use special bingo cards that have large print with pull down tabs. They are very expensive to buy. We were able to purchase two cases of these. Bingo at Leeds is done once a month ten months of the year which cost \$150.00 per month.

Large print playing cards were purchased thru out the year for them as well.

Christmas gift bags are done for 300 Veterans. Everyone gets a gift bag filled with hats, combs, playing cards, dice, socks, Elks veterans pins, fruit cup, canteen bucks, chap stick, hand lotion and Christmas cards. We purchased an extra \$200.00 in "canteen bucks" used to purchase items at the canteen or the retail store

Just wanted to let you all know that your support helps a lot and we assure you the Veterans greatly appreciate it, you are not there to the hear the thanks and the claps we get when we are there, so we as the committee are giving you thanks from them. We have a very supportive lodge!

That being said when you see us with yet another raffle stop and remember all that we were able to do for our Veterans who fought for our freedom.




