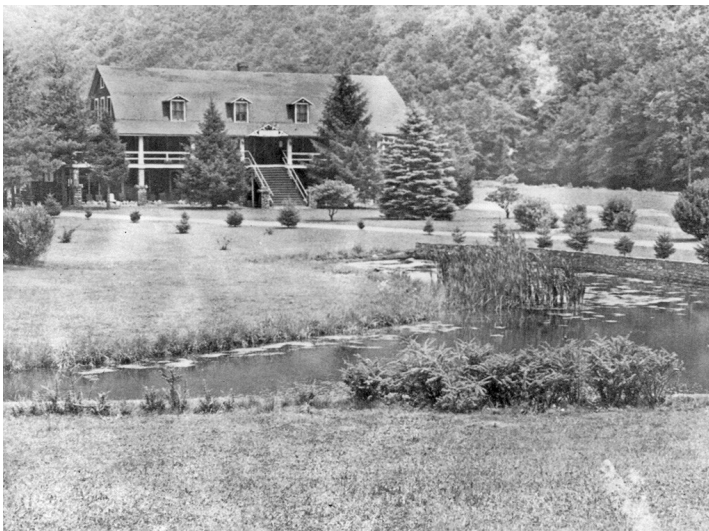

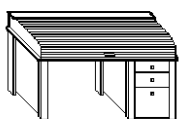
Renovo's Lodge #334, Elks Country Club, probably around the late 1950's or early 60's. The Country Club was host to many wedding receptions, high school class reunion, Pennsylvania Railroad Apprentice Program (PRR) graduation dinners and the locally famous PRR Shop Picnics. Due to a sagging local economy brought on by the downsizing of the local PRR shops the Country Club was sold in the late 1960s. A few years after the sale of the property the main building was lost to a fire.
