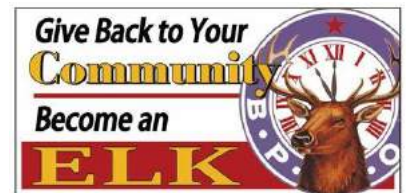
Betty Burt Celebration of Life
