Greetings ELKS:

June is now upon us. Also, a huge Thank you to all our lodge volunteers for your hard work and dedication. We appreciate you!

One of the events this month will be our mandatory Flag Day Service on June 15th at 1:00pm. The Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks was the first fraternal organization to observe Flag Day. In 1907, the BPOE officially designated June 14th as Flag Day and the fraternal order has celebrated it every year since. In 1911, they made the event mandatory for all lodges to observe this special occasion.

The Elks even pushed the sitting President to give Flag Day its official status which finally happened in 1949. Some interesting facts about the American Flag: Fifty flags fly 24 hours a day around the Washington monument, Pennsylvania is the only state that observes Flag Day as a state holiday and did you know the design of the current 50-star flag is commonly credited to Robert G. Heft, a 17-year-old high school student at the time. Also, the military folds the flag with 13 folds, with each fold holding a special significance.
