### BPOE #37 History Corner



Being an Elk has always been about serving our community. This was especially true during the Depression. In 1933, the Columbus Elks Lodge began a program, under the direction of Fred Hertel, to supply food and toys to needy individuals. Hertel discovered that merchants were disposing of fruits and vegetables that they were unable to sell. He also learned that excess materials were being destroyed because there were no paying customers to buy them. Hertel and his committee obtained the food before it spoiled so it could be redistributed to people in need. The excess materials went to trade and vocational schools where it was "turned into toys for children, articles for beautification for the City and other useful objects." These efforts fed hundreds of needy persons.

The photo, from April 7, 1939, shows Hertel delivering food to a home where 70 people from 17 families, all on relief, were living. The house is a rebuilt barn that had no plumbing facilities.
