REOPENING PLAN JUNE 2020

- 1) Our maximum capacity has been set by the Grand Rapids Fire Marshal at 180. When we reopen, our capacity will be reduced by 50%, meaning no more than 90 people will be allowed at any given time.
- 2) To gain entry, you must display a current member, spouse, widow or widower card. Care takers are also allowed. No guests allowed. If you do not have a paid up membership, you may enter and pay at the bar immediately upon entry.
- 3) You are required to wear a mask upon entering the building. Once you reach your seat, you may remove your mask to eat and/or drink. Mask use is required by the State of Michigan.
- 4) Bartenders and volunteers are required to wear face coverings (covering the nose, mouth and chin).
- 5) Any employee, volunteer or member that does not feel well, should not enter the building or Lodge for any reason. If you are scheduled to work or volunteer, but do not feel well, please contact the Lodge so that a replacement can be found.
- 6) If you are experiencing symptoms of Covid-19, or develop them in the Lodge, please isolate yourself and seek medical care. Should anyone test positive and have visited the Lodge while they were, we will be required to shut down the Lodge for deep cleaning and sanitizing.
- 7) All employees are required to regularly wash their hands (which has always been the case). The Lodge also has hand sanitizers at the entrance, bar, rest rooms and at various locations. Please feel free to use this sanitizer upon entering or exiting the lounge, or when you are unable to wash your hand with soap and water for 20 seconds.
- 8) The seating area will look and feel different. All tables are positioned to maintain social distancing guidelines mandated by the State of Michigan.
- 9) Ordering of food and drinks for those not seated at the bar will be handled at the ordering station which is located at the bar by the pull tab machines. There will be X's on the ground to assist with maintaining social distancing while ordering.
- 10) All common area self-serve items will be removed. This includes but is not limited to napkins, condiments, straws, stir sticks, salt/pepper shakers. These will be provided upon request to reduce contact. Popcorn will be available upon request and served by the bartender.
- 11) Bar staff will regularly clean and sanitize common surfaces prior to opening, at regular periods during operation and again at closing time. Red cards will be placed to tables which need to be cleaned and should not be used. Green cards on a table/bar stool indicate that it has been cleaned.
- 12) Keno slips and pencils will be available at the bar only.
