HOUSE RULES

1. Club Room hours will be set by the House Committee and published in the monthly Lodge bulletin. The Bar Room will be closed during all Lodge sessions.

A. The hours may be changed for dances, banquets, etc., with prior approval of the House Committee. Also, with prior authorization, the Club may be closed for Club wide functions or holidays at the option of the House Committee.

B. Closing time will be announced ten minutes prior to closing and all operations must cease on the hour. Members are expected to vacate the premises as soon as possible.

2. All persons in question must show their Elks card to the Attendant at the Club. The Attendant has full authority to refuse any person(s) or guest(s) admittance to the Club.

3. All Members must show their paid-up membership card to cash a personal check. The amount of the check will be limited to the discretion of the Club Manager or designate.

4. All visiting Members must sign the Register before admittance to the Club.

5. The Club Room will be for Members only, in good standing of Quincy Lodge or visitors of other Lodges and guests will be limited to the following:

A. Each Member may have a limited amount of guests at the discretion of Manager or House Committee.

B. Minors in the Bar Room must be accompanied by a Member.

C. When a guest(s) is/are taken into the Club Room, the host Member shall be responsible for the guest(s) conduct and must remain with guest(s) while the guest(s) is/are there.

D. Guests are limited to three (3) visits per Elk fraternal year.

E. All guests must sign Guest Register for each visit.

F. Immediate family and significant others are exempt from 5. D and E.

G. Guests are to enter the Lodge with the Member or be met at the entrance by the Member.

6. Foul and profane language does not belong in the Club. Members are asked to be careful of the language they use.

7. The Club will not be responsible for lost or stolen items.

8. The operation of the Club will be supervised by the Club Manager or designate, who will direct operations of all departments in the Club.

9. The Club Manager will report to the House Committee and shall receive instruction from no other source.

10. Any suggestion or complaints, in writing, will be welcomed by the House Committee.

11. No Member(s), guest(s) or visitor(s) will be permitted to remain in the Club, if, in the judgment of the Club Manager or designate, said person fails to properly conduct themselves.

12. Any Member having been refused service, admission to the Club, or requested to leave the Club, shall accept such action as being in the best interest of the Club; and shall make no further issue of the matter with any employee of the Club.

13. The House Committee has the authority, under Grand Lodge Statutes, to suspend a Member for up to one year.

14. Members are not allowed behind the bar except when requested by the Club Manager or House Committee.

15. Members should not frequent the kitchen except when special occasions occur, or requested to by the Club Manager or House Committee.

16. Phone calls will not be made at the bar phone. Numbers will be given to the Bartender, who will dial the number, while not serving, and the calls will be taken at the red courtesy phone.

17. The office is for business only. It should be locked at all times.

18. A contracted band member may have one (1) guest per engagement. A contracted band member is responsible for their own food and drink.

ATTIRE

1. Gentlemen may wear hats in the Member's Lounge/Bar area only. Exceptions will be made for special occasions such as theme dances, etc. in the Banquet area of the Lodge.

2. No shirt, no shoes, no service.

Elks Care - Elks Share

*If I drop my Elk Membership
can I come into the Lodge as a Guest of a Member or Widow?*

**This question has been put forth many times
and I decided to Print the answer 'Below' according to the
BPOE Statutes Annotated.**

Statutes Annotated Section 14.190

Except for the non-suspended spouse of a Member, an unaffiliated Member shall not be permitted to visit any Lodge. No unaffiliated Member shall join as an Elk in any public procession or display of the Order; or to display or use any emblem of the Order, nor shall he or she receive relief or burial by a Lodge.

Opinions 02

Members of either gender who become unaffiliated Elks
(except non-suspended spouse of a Member)

may not visit any Lodge's

Club or other facilities, nor does Section 14.140 allow issuance to them of identification cards.

Opinions 03

The exception permitting visitation of a Lodge by a non-suspended spouse, or a delinquent Member spouse, means that the non-suspended or unaffiliated spouse is treated as if he or she were never a Member.

**The following is 'clarification' about Statutes Annotated Section 14.190 stated above...
by (Lodge Secretary)...**

An example of a non-suspended spouse as stated above is...a married couple who both have joined as Members then one of the spouses decide to drop their Membership. This spouse may continue to visit the Lodge as if he or she were never a Member and can be issued an Identification spouse card.

**An unaffiliated Elk means a Member who has dropped his or her Membership by request
via an Absolute Dimit or was dropped from the rolls for non-payment of dues.
An unaffiliated Elk in good standing may not be a Guest or participate in any
Lodge functions.**

They may apply for 'Reinstatement' into the Lodge by means of the
'Reinstatement' application.

*To make things a little clearer...a dropped member/an unaffiliated Elk member may go to the
Lodge when it is 'rented' for a Wedding Reception/Party by a third party
because it is not a Lodge function.*

*Bingo is not a Lodge function because it is rented by the Firefighter's.
An unaffiliated Member may not avail themselves to privileges of the Bar or
Dining Room Banquet Hall when it is run as a regular Lodge function.
Monthly Karaoke and Dances are Lodge functions*
